

EL 2 News

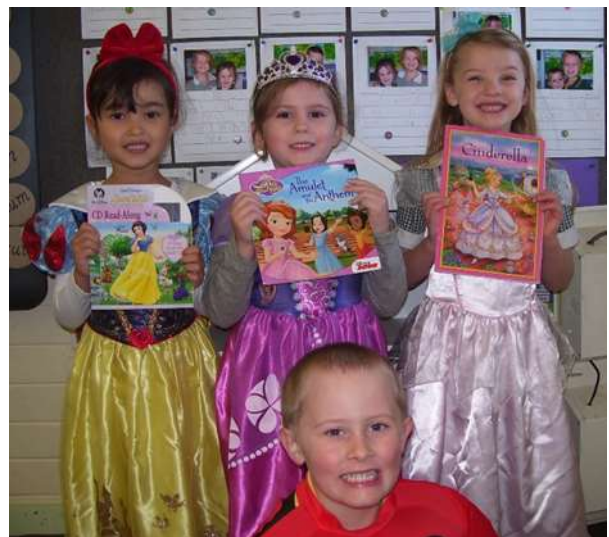
