All classes involved in planting native plants in the space between the vegie patch and the chook pen.

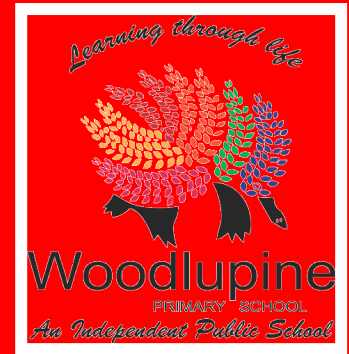
Day of Sport
