

Dress Code

General

- School Jacket / Jumper with Logo or Leavers Jacket for Year 6 (Uniform Shop)
- School Polo Shirt with Logo or Leavers Shirt for Year 6 (Uniform Shop)
- Sports Faction Polo Shirt (Uniform Shop)
- Black tracksuit bottoms or black pants (no other colours/logos on items)
- Black shorts / skorts / skirts (no other colours / logos on items)
- Black broad brim hat for outdoors activities (no caps)

Hats

- We are a sun smart school and have a 'NO HAT NO PLAY' policy in place for the health and safety of students. Only broad brimmed hats are acceptable as caps do not offer sufficient protection from UV rays.

Shoes

- School shoes, joggers or sandals - no heels.

Hair

- Hair that is shoulder length or longer must be tied back.

Makeup

- Makeup is not allowed. This includes nail polish and false nails.

Jewellery

- Stud / sleeper earrings only.

Cultural/Religious Clothing

- Any undershirt / skivvy, stockings / tights or cultural headwear that is white or black.

Special Uniform Items

- A number of special uniform items are supplied and maintained by the school. These include Choir and Interschool shirts.

Policy

All public schools have a uniform that students must wear every day.

The school uniform is a visible representation of the standards expected of students and plays an important role in promoting a positive image of the school.

It also creates a sense of identity and pride among the students and wider school community, and helps students learn the importance of appropriate presentation.

School Board

Our uniform creates a sense of identity and pride among the students and wider school community. It features the echidna, the totem animal of the traditional custodians of this land - the Whadjuk Noongar people.

Our Dress Code is ratified by the School Board. The uniforms are sensible, practical and attractive and help develop a school identity.

Some items can be purchased at local shops, however these must meet the dress code of black. Students will need to be in full uniform in order to

take part in events representing the school such as Interschool events, Choir excursions and incursions.

Parents and students will be informed of the school dress code at the time of enrolment when any grounds for exemption should be raised.

Acceptance of enrolment at this school assumes an agreement that the enrolling student will dress within the guidelines of the dress code.

Ordering

The school orders uniforms in bulk twice a year. Notification will be sent via Connect and ordering can be accessed via the Woodlupine PS website (www.woodlupineps.wa.edu.au).

Limited stock is held in the Uniform Shop outside of the bulk orders.

Payment

Invoices will be issued direct to parents via email. Once uniforms have been received they will be delivered direct to your child.

Payment must be received prior to uniforms being delivered.
